The package will provide users with viewing access to the Exchange's Electronic Trading System on a real-time basis and the opportunity to analyze market trends in a timely manner.

Subscribers will have real time access to the following:

1. *Bid and ask prices for all equity, mutual fund and bond securities listed on the TTSE;*
2. *Trading activity in all securities and across all sectors;*
3. *Market trends based on Index movements.*

The package has been tailored to display specific information to users in key areas of interest.

The following information is provided in the viewer package:

Market Summary: The Market Summary Worksheet displays real-time trade information by security, by sector and by market for all securities listed on the TTSE. The Market Summary provides the following information:

Column Name	Description
Symbol	The symbol for the security.
Security	The name of the security.
Trades	The total number of trades executed today.
Volume Traded TOTAL	The total volume traded today.
Volume Traded BUY	The total volume traded today for securities where the bid side of the market was aggressive.
Volume Traded SELL	The total volume traded today for securities where the ask side of the market was aggressive.
Value Traded TOTAL	The total value traded today.
Value Traded BUY	The total value traded today for securities where the bid side of the market was aggressive.
Value Traded SELL	The total value traded today for securities where the bid side of the market was aggressive.
Close	The Volume Weighted Average Price for the trades today on this security.

Indices: The Indices Worksheet provides real-time access to the security, sector and market indices for securities listed on the TTSE. The following information is provided:

Column Name	Description
Sector	The sector or market to which the security belongs.
Symbol	The symbol for the security.
Security	The name of the security.
Issued Share Capital	The Issued Share Capital for the security.
Market Capitalization	The Market Capitalization value for the security.
Current Index	The Current Index value for the security, sector or market.

Watchlists: The Watchlists available in GV are customizable and provide real-time trading statistics. Columns with **(D)** next to the name will be displayed in the default Workbook. All other columns in the table below can be added by users. The Watchlists provide the following information:

Column Name	Description
Symbol (D)	The symbol for the security.
Status (D)	The current market state of the security.
Bid Qty (D)	The aggregated quantity of the orders at the best price on the bid side of the market.

Column Name	Description
Bid (D)	The best price of a bid order for a security in the market.
Ask (D)	The best price of an ask order for a security in the market.
Ask Qty (D)	The aggregated quantity of the orders at the best price on the ask side of the market.
Opening Price (D)	The Opening price for the security for the current trading day.
Closing Price (D)	The Volume Weighted Average Price for the trades today on this security.
Change (D)	The difference between Opening Price and Last Traded Price.
% Change (D)	The percentage difference between Opening Price and Last Traded Price.
Dir (D)	Indicates the difference between the last traded price and previous price traded before that. The direction and colour of the triangle shows the direction of the market. A red (down) triangle indicates the last trade was at a worse price than the previous trade, a green (up) triangle indicates the last trade was at a better price than the previous trade, and a black (neutral) dash indicates the last trade was at the same price as the previous trade.
Total Trades (D)	The total number of trades executed today.
Total Volume (D)	The total volume traded today.
Total Value (D)	The total value traded today.
Last Traded Price (D)	The price of the last trade for this security.
Last Traded Volume	The quantity of the security that traded in the last trade.
Last Traded (D)	The date and time the last trade on this security took place.
High (D)	The best price traded for the current trading day.
Low (D)	The worst price traded for the current trading day.
Name	The name of the security.
Best Traded Quantity	The quantity of the first trade at the best price traded for the current trading day.
Coupon Rate	The coupon rate for interest bearing securities.
Currency	The currency the security is traded in.
Maturity Date	The maturity date for the security.
Open	The opening auction price.
Payments/Year	The number of interest payments per year for interest bearing securities.
Index Base	The base value used in the index calculation for the security.
Issued Share Capital	The issued share capital for the security.

Deals

The Deals window is reflects details of trades executed in the market. The following information is displayed in the Deals window and can be sorted by any of the columns:

Column Name	Description
Deal ID	The consecutive id numbers assigned to trades.
Instrument	The security name.
Quantity	The volume traded.
Price	The price of the trade.
Value	The value of the trade.
Unit	The type of security traded.
Aggressor Company	The company that submitted an order that hit a bid or offer.
Aggressor Trader	The trader or broker that submitted an order that hit a bid or offer. This can only be seen if the trader/broker is from the same company.
Initiator Company	The company that submitted an order to the market.
Initiator Trader	The trader or broker that submitted an order to the market This can only be seen if the trader/broker is from the same company.
Account Reference (B)	The TTCD account of the buying client.
Source (B)	The source of the TTCD account of the buying client.
OrderRef (B)	The order reference entered by the buying broker.
Account Reference (S)	The TTCD account of the selling client.
Source (S)	The source of the TTCD account of the selling client.
OrderRef (S)	The order reference entered by the selling broker.
Time	The date and time the trade was executed.

TTSE Websheet

The TTSE Websheet titled “Welcome to TTSE” provides users with easy access to the Exchange’s website.

Activity Ticker

The Activity Ticker shows details of the current day’s market activity, such as trades that have taken place, and orders being added, updated, withheld and/or deleted.

Market Depth

The Market Depth window displays all orders for the selected security.

Deal Ticker

The deal ticker displays the symbol, volume, price and direction of trades executed for the day.
